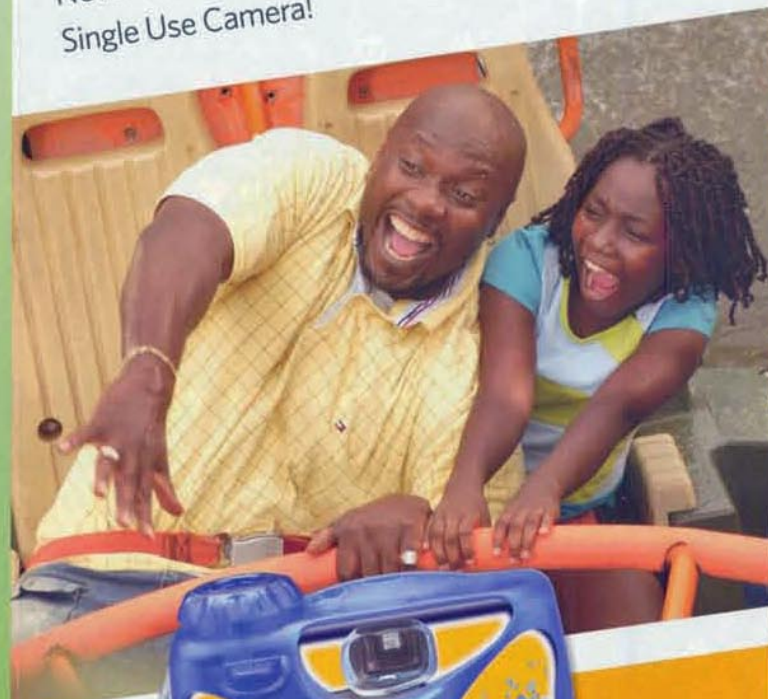

You'll receive a FASTPASS ticket with a return time so you can go play in the Park instead of waiting in line.



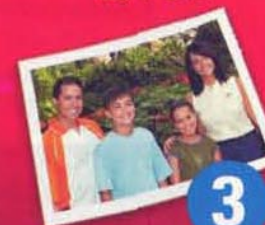
Come back during your return time and hop on the attraction with little or no waiting.
